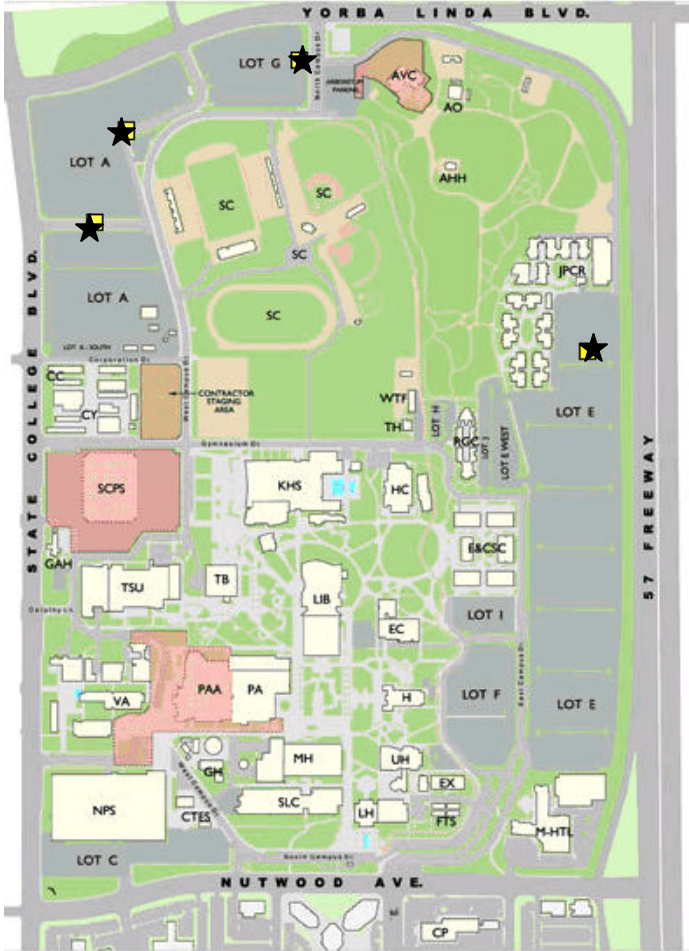

From 57S: Exit Yorba Linda Blvd. and turn right. Turn left at State College Blvd., then turn left into Lot A.

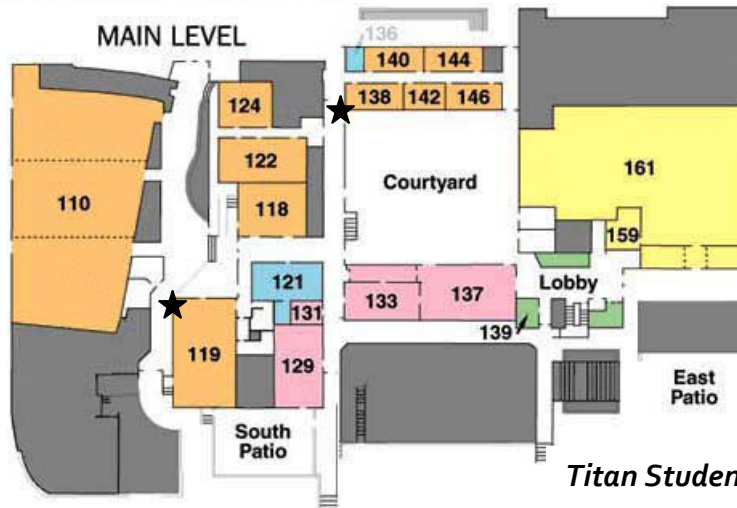
Parking
