Parking Information

Parking Locations

- If you are planning on attending the symposium only: The State College parking structure (SCPS, marked with a yellow square on the upper map) on Gymnasium Dr. is the closest parking structure to the Titan Student Union (yellow star on the upper map), where the symposium will be held.


Enter the campus at Entrance #6 (from State College Blvd. onto Gymnasium Dr.) and turn into the parking structure.

- If you are planning on attending the symposium and the reception: The Eastside South parking structure (ESPS, marked with a red rectangle on the upper map) on Folino Drive is the closest parking structure to the Humanities Building (purple rectangle on the upper map), where the reception will be held.


Enter the campus at Entrance #1 (from Nutwood Ave. onto Folino Dr.) and park in the first parking structure.

Parking Costs

- If you are planning on attending the symposium and the reception: A daily permit may be purchased (\$10, credit and debit card only, American Express not accepted) from permit machines on levels 2 and above of the State College, Nutwood, and Eastside South parking structures. Permit machines are also available in Lots A, D, and G. Daily permits are valid in student lots and parking structures, unless restricted.
- If you are planning on attending a portion of the symposium, hourly permits (\$4 per hour) may be purchased using the ParkMobile app (a contactless option hourly permits not available from daily permit machines). Hourly parking spaces are available on the ground level of the State College, Nutwood, and Eastside South parking structures.
