The Department of Geography & the Environment is accepting applications for Barbara Weightman Scholarships for CSUF Geography M.A. students. The maximum award is \$500.

This scholarship was established to honor the memory of Dr. Barbara A. Weightman. Dr. Weightman joined the CSUF Geography faculty in 1972, and held positions as graduate advisor and department chair during her 37-year tenure at CSUF. Funding for the Weightman Scholarship has been generously provided by anonymous donors to the department to commemorate Dr. Weightman's interests in fieldwork and supporting graduate students.

PURPOSE OF AWARD: These awards will be used to fund travel, supplies, and other expenses directly related to thesis research. Conference registration and travel expenses can also be supported if relevant for thesis research. Priority will be given to projects involving fieldwork.

ELIGIBILITY: The Weightman Scholarship is available to all degree-seeking CSUF Geography graduate students in good standing, with an accumulated M.A. grade point average of at least 3.00.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Preference will be given to applicants seeking funding for travel or supplies to perform research for the purposes of completing a thesis. Academic performance and the appropriateness of scope and budget will also be considered.

DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS: Funds will be distributed upon receipt of an expense report documenting individual expenditures. Retain and submit receipts for all expenses. All funds must be used before 31 December 2017.

- A letter of reference from your thesis advisor.
